DESCRIPTION

The Assistant Professor will teach courses in **Core Physics** subjects like Classical Mechanics, Quantum Mechanics, Mathematical Methods, Spectroscopy, Solid State Physics and Statistical Thermodynamics to students of the **B.Sc. (Hons.) in Physics** and **M.Sc. in Physics** programmes at a **Men's Campus** at SSSIHL.

Additionally, he will be required to actively participate in extra-curricular activities involving students. This forms an important part of the Sri Sathya Sai System of values-based Integral Education.

REQUIREMENTS

- > A good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade) at a master's degree (in the relevant field) from an Indian university, or an equivalent degree from an accredited university abroad.
- > Successful qualification in the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, or a similar test accredited by the UGC (e.g. SLET/SET/GATE).
(Candidates with a Ph.D. shall be exempt from this requirement)
- > Strong conceptual understanding of core Physics subjects is essential.
- > Proficiency in English is necessary to effectively communicate with students.
- > A passion for teaching is desirable
- > Appreciation and willingness to live a disciplined life, based on the basic human values as enunciated by Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba is essential.
