SSSIHL's integral items fall under 5 dimensions viz. (1) Intellectual (2) Physical (3) Cultural (4) Service and (5) Spiritual.


The IQAC team proposed a multidimensional student Impact Assessment survey to assess the benefit perceived by students in each of the five activities under each of the above five dimensions.




In all 5 dimensions, the degree of perceived benefit is Immense or Moderate for more than 90% of students in all 3 categories: UG, PG and Professional courses.


