The meeting started with a prayer to Bhagawan.

The Coordinator SSSIHL-IQAC (henceforth referred to as IQAC) welcomed all the members of the IQAC team and the NAAC Steering Team Champions (henceforth referred to as NST).

Submission of AQAR 2022-23:

The Coordinator IQAC informed the members that the process of collection and consolidation of data for AQAR 2022-23 using Pi360 has commenced.

Quality Initiatives taken up by the Institute thus far:

Coordinator IQAC emphasised the fact that any quality initiative undertaken by the members of the Institute fraternity (may not be comprehensive), is being enlisted as part of the documentation.

The Coordinator IQAC highlighted all the initiatives taken up by the IQAC after the First Quarter IQAC meeting held on the 26th August 2023.

Checklists prepared for Faculty; awaiting deployment of newly proposed CAS:

In the context of NAAC checklists prepared jointly by the IQAC team and the NAAC Steering Teams, Coordinator IQAC informed the members that it would be shared with the stakeholders after the newly proposed Career Advancement Scheme (CAS) is implemented. He then requested the Chairperson



IQAC to share details of the newly proposed CAS.

Chairperson IQAC briefly explained to the members about the Research track, Teaching track, Administrative track, Fast track and Performance Improvement Programme (PIP) track.

Dr. Padmavathy enquired whether teaching has been given due importance in the new CAS. Chairperson IQAC said that teaching has been given due importance in all the different tracks.

Faculty Members to attend Conferences, workshops every year, Apply for Membership with Professional Academic Bodies - NAAC Metric 6.3.2 - Funding and Leave Clearance:

Speaking about the initiative of providing financial assistance to faculty members under NAAC Metric 6.3.2, Chairperson IQAC emphasized that every faculty member and every research scholar will be provided financial assistance for travel outside India for participation in an international conference once in 3 years and in the last year of his / her PhD respectively.

Dr. Rama, the external expert suggested that all these initiatives should be duly communicated to all the stakeholders through circulars, emails etc. and the proof of this communication should be available as proof to be uploaded on NAAC portal.

Institution Innovation Council (IIC) Constitution – NAAC Metric 3.3.1 Innovation Ecosystem – Various activities conducted by IIC since then:

Registrar talking about the reconstitution of IIC and highlighted the importance of the innovation ecosystem in the Institute as this has been made mandatory by UGC. He also said that this will help in applying for NIRF innovation ranking.

Dr. M Muralikrishna informed the members that the IIC is organizing a day-long event as part of Start-Up Day celebrations on 16th January 2024.

Dr B E Pradeep updated the members that the IPR team of IIC is working on preparing templates for IPR policy, MoU preparation and timelines for MoU approval.

MoU with the All India Institute of Speech and Hearing, Mysuru – NAAC Metric 3.7.2:

Chairperson IQAC updated the members about the initiatives undertaken under the MoU signed with the All India Institute of Speech and Hearing (AIISH).

Prof. Rani P L updated the members that students of Department of Languages and Literature have taken up dissertation work related to topics of speech.



Brass Band and Vedam Chanting by women students on the XLII Convocation Day of SSSIHL – Initiative by Chairperson IQAC:

Prof. Srividya elaborating on the initiative of inclusivity and gender equality said that the women students of the Institute got an opportunity to play brass band and chant invocatory Vedam for the first time at the XLII Annual Convocation of the Institute. She added that the Honourable President of India, the Chief Guest for the Convocation, Smt. Droupadi Murmu, was very happy with the performance of the women students and took a photograph with them.

Proposed Policy for Online Credit Transfer from SWAYAM at SSSIHL – NAAC Metric 1.3.2:

Dr. B E Pradeep, talking about the new guidelines of Online Credit Transfer from SWAYAM, suggested that these guidelines should be highlighted in the admissions prospectus and the Institute website to create awareness amongst prospective applicants.

Proposed Question Paper Setting and Answer Scripts Evaluation Policy at SSSIHL – NAAC Metric 2.5 Evaluation Process and Reforms:

Sri Prasanth Raju observed that the Institute should take up a process of checking the effectiveness of the single evaluation system by sampling method.

Dr. B E Pradeep suggested that the Institute can check which faculty member's correction goes for double/triple evaluation and take corrective action.

Prof. Srividya suggested that the Controller of Examination(CoE) take a relook at the grade sheet in light of the introduction of the NEP-2020 curriculum. CoE welcomed any suggestions in the relook of the grade sheets.

Constitution of the SSSIHL Public Outreach Committee (SPOC):

Chairperson IQAC directed all the members to communicate to the staff and students of their respective campuses to record any event conducted in their campus and bring it to the notice of SSSIHL Public Outreach Committee (SPOC). He highlighted how the recent delegation of IAS and IPS officers were very impressed by the display of our students in the Annual Sports and Cultural Meet held on 11th January 2024.

Sri Sathya Sai Mudigonda updated the members about a social media training that was conducted on 24th December 2023 for members of the SPOC.

Dy. Coordinator IQAC suggested that akin to international conferences organized jointly by the Department of Physics and Department of Chemistry in 2015, we should organize more such



conferences.

Chairperson IQAC suggested that as part of centenary celebrations of Revered Founder Chancellors' advent, we can target at organizing international conferences and invite the who's who in every domain.

Chairperson IQAC updated the members that very soon the Institute is going to register an alumni association and alumni have come forward in helping us in consolidating the alumni database. He added that all the alumni will be provided with alumni ID cards.

Coordinator IQAC then requested inputs and volunteers for contribution to the metrics 6.5.1, and 6.5.2. Referring to 6.5.1 and 6.5.2, Dr. Rama Reddy suggested that a resolution shall be taken in the IQAC meeting stating that any initiative in the Institute taken for quality enhancement shall be considered as an IQAC initiative.

Other points

Feedback mechanism:

Talking about quality enhancement of the teaching quality feedback (TQF) process, Dr. Padmavathy highlighted the need to have a relook at the questionnaires which are administered to the students at the end of every semester. Chairperson IQAC suggested that we should customize these questionnaires for different programmes.

Dr. Prathibha suggested that time given to the students to give the feedback should be relooked to prevent fatigue. Chairperson IQAC directed the Coordinator IQAC to initiate the process of relooking at the TQF questionnaires.

Dr. B E Pradeep suggested that IQAC can reach out to the students on a one-on-one basis to get their inputs for improving the questionnaires.

Sri Prasanth Raju enquired about a process to elicit feedback from the faculty members. Coordinator IQAC informed the members that we have two feedback mechanisms annually, a) Feedback as part of Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA) and b) Feedback as part of design and review of syllabus.

Other Quality Enhancement Initiatives

Dr. Balasubramanian highlighted few quality enhancement initiatives:

- More clarity in communication across the Institute
- Guidelines to be framed and circulated for conduct of different meetings

Chairperson IQAC informed the members that documents clearly spelling out the roles and responsibilities of every position in the Institute will be shared soon.

Coordinator IQAC took note of the points for action.

Prof. Rani P L shared the following points:



- Need for accurate data for placement and higher studies from graduating students every year.
- Preparation of a few general videos on NEP-2020 be made and put on social media and website to give wider publicity to the SSSIHL's NEP-2020 implementation.
- Referring to the initiative of framing intermediate level courses for those Self-reliance courses
 which are being converted to Value Added Courses, she suggested a relook to avoid any
 confusion and overlap in their nomenclature.
- Referring to the adoption of single valuation as part of examination reforms, she said the faculty should exhibit utmost integrity in the valuation of the answer scripts.
- A relook at the TQF as pointed out by other members of the IQAC team.
- Encouraging differently-abled students to study at SSSIHL and having a teaching-learning-evaluation policy suitable for them.
- Setting up an evaluation process for HoDs, Deans, Administration and Faculty.
- Any achievements of the students and faculty should be appreciated.

Ms. Janaki T underscored the importance of putting in efforts to retain the cream of students from the Sri Sathya Sai Schools. She informed the members that most of the students of Smt. Eswaramma High School go out and do not join SSSIHL. Dr. B E Pradeep apprised Ms. Janaki T that efforts are being made to reach out to the students of our schools.

Dr. Padmavathy appreciated the active involvement of alumni in the placement of students of SSSIHL. She stressed on the need for having a placement policy, which should be communicated to the students.

Dr. B E Pradeep suggested that when we celebrate National Science Day, we can intimate the nearby schools in advance and invite them to the Institute to witness and perform some experiments in our labs.

Dr. Prathibha apprised the members about the wellness programs organized by premier institutions like the IITs where they do it just for one session inviting an expert to share his/her thoughts. In comparison, in SSSIHL we have events like Summer Course in Indian Culture and Spirituality, Moral Class etc. where experts share their thoughts with students and staff on a regular basis. She added that we have a rich collection of Bhagawan's discourses which are played regularly on different occasions in Hostel, Institute and Mandir. She stressed on the need for allowing our students to participate in intra university and inter university competitions. These points were noted by the Coordinator IQAC.

Deputy Coordinator IQAC informed the members that according to the communication received in a recent workshop conducted by AICTE where he was a participant, NBA accreditation will be mandatory and has to be undertaken in the next one year.



Dr. Rama Reddy added that NBA pre-qualifier needs extensive preparation and urged the concerned departments to start in right earnest.

The meeting concluded with a prayer.
